

ESOL classes in schools and Children's Centres

Many primary schools run short ESOL courses for parents who have children in the school, usually 2 hours per week, sometimes with childcare. Call the school to check. Some Children's Centres also sometimes run ESOL classes for any parent in the local area, sometimes with childcare.
