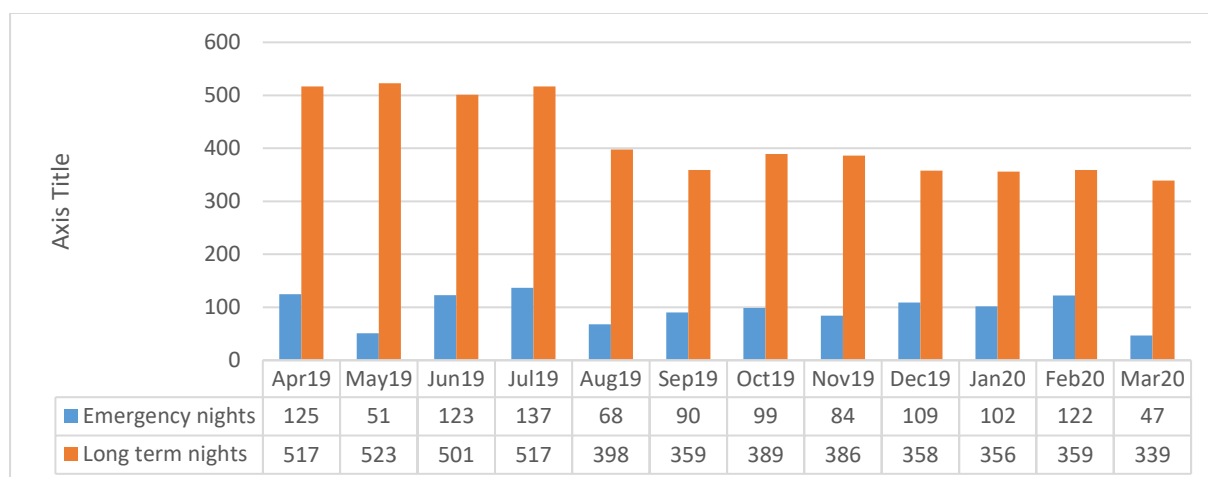


Summary of Grace Hosting Apr19 – Mar20

Overall, 47 hosts accommodated 59 different people over 6159 nights



Short Stay – 1241 nights offered, 1157 nights provided

- 84 people were referred for emergency accommodation – on 681 separate occasions. 69 (82%) of them were men, 15 (18%) of them were women.
- Emergency accommodation was found on 473 occasions (69% of the time)
- 35 men and 10 women stayed with short stay hosts
- Men accounted for 916 (89%) of the total nights spent in emergency accommodation, and women accounted for 123 nights (11%).
- The average length of time spent in emergency accommodation was 26 days for men and 12 days for women.

Long Stay – 5002 nights provided

- 25 guests were accommodated in longer term placements – 20 (80%) men, 5 (20%) women.
- The average length of time spent in emergency accommodation was 200 nights (233 nights for men, 67 for women).

Hosts - 47 hosting households, comprising 63 trained volunteers

- 32 households offered emergency hosting, and 15 households offered longer term hosting during the year. 5 households offered both long and short term hosting.

Sources of Referral

- British Red Cross (BRC) referred 33 people to short stay (37%) and PAFRAS referred 51 people (63%).
- 26 (79%) of BRC referrals were men and 7 (21%) were women.
- 18 of the 26 men (69%) referred by BRC were accommodated
- 5 of the 7 women (71%) referred by BRC were accommodated
- 43 (84%) of PAFRAS referrals were men and 8 (16%) were women
- 18 the 43 men (42%) referred by PAFRAS were accommodated
- 5 of the 8 women (63%) referred by PAFRAS were accommodated
